## Look What We Can Be Spotted Learning This Week!

### Language Arts & Writing:

In reading, students will focus on conclusions and author's word choice. In writing, use sentence variety, proper conventions, and dialogue when writing a narrative. Daily cursive packet. **Tests** on using a dictionary, vocabulary in context, and comprehension.

### Math TEST Monday ch.1

This week, we are problem solving and representing data using tallies, pictographs, and bar graphs. Continue addition and subtraction math facts.

### Science/Social Science

Begin social studies geography unit. Where are we in the world? Students will learn how to use maps.

### PBIS - Positive Behaviors, Interventions, & Supports:
