Bottoms	<u>Options for Boys:</u> Pants Shorts <b>(No sweatpants)</b>  <u>Options for Girls:</u> Skirts/skorts Jumpers w/collared shirt Dresses must be solid Colored w/Collar Dress in uniform colors (Black, White, Navy Blue, Tan, Gray) Pants Shorts <b>(No sweatpants or athletic wear (active/bike shorts or legging type shorts))</b>	Black White Navy Blue Tan Gray	Cotton Cotton Blend Cotton twill Corduroy Denim or denim-like in appearance (Friday only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be fitted at waist (no more than one size too large or one size too small).</li> <li>Pant hems should be 1-inch from floor with shoes on and not bunched up at ankle.</li> <li>All bottoms may not be cut, stapled, torn, or frayed.</li> <li>Shorts, skirts, and skorts must be no shorter than 6" above the knee.</li> <li>Capri length is allowed.</li> <li>Blue jeans or blue jean like (in appearance) will be allowed only on Fridays with spirit wear.</li> <li>No denim or denim looking pants or shorts of any color are allowed Monday through Thursday</li> <li>Solid colors only. No stripes.</li> <li>Leggings/bike shorts allowed under shorts or skirt, provided shorts or skirt is no shorter than 6" above the knee.</li> </ul>

Jackets		Black White Navy Blue Brown Gray	Cotton Cotton Blends Rayon Nylon Wool Wool Blends	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Solid color or any combination of the uniform colors.</li> <li>No logos/lettering greater than 2x2."</li> <li>Vests are not allowed, unless they are of thermal benefit (no decorative vests are allowed).</li> <li>All visible parts of jackets, including lining, must be any color from jacket uniform colors.</li> </ul>

Shoes	Flat, closed toe shoes only, tennis shoes, boots	Black White Brown Navy Blue Silver/Gray (applies to shoelaces as well)	No restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid colors or a combination of uniform colors for shoes.</li> <li>• No logos/lettering greater than 2x2" or standard manufacturers logo and must be within shoe uniform colors.</li> <li>• Sandals, flip-flops, platforms, strapless shoes, or high heels are not acceptable.</li> <li>• No flames, skulls, or lights.</li> </ul>
Socks	Socks must not extend higher than the bottom of the knee	Black White Navy Blue Gray	No restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid colors or a combination of no more than 2 uniform colors only (colors listed to the left).</li> <li>• No embellishments.</li> </ul>
Belts	Dress belts Leather belts Cloth belts	Black White Brown Navy Blue	Leather Fabric	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• End of belt cannot extend more than 3-inches beyond the first belt loop.</li> <li>• Belt buckle should not have any obscene, alcohol, or drug related symbols. No spikes, rivets, studs, or additional applications.</li> </ul>
Caps / Scarves/ Head coverings	Beanie, baseball style	Black White Navy Blue, or combination of uniform colors.	Cotton knit Cotton blend	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Caps cannot be worn inside buildings.</li> <li>• Caps must be plain unless sporting school logo.</li> </ul>
Hair Styles	Hair style and/or color should not cause classroom distractions	No unnatural hair colors or woven/glued additions (blue, pink, etc.).		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hair (male) should not exceed collar.</li> <li>• Hair should not hinder classroom instruction in anyway (i.e.-in eyes, etc.)</li> <li>• No mohawks, excessive "spiking", etc.</li> <li>• See Sanger Unified dress code policy.</li> <li>•</li> </ul>
Hair Ribbons / Barrettes		Black White Navy Blue Teal Silver Tan	No restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hair accessories should not cause a distraction.</li> <li>• Hair accessories must be in uniform colors.</li> </ul>
Backpacks / Binders	Backpacks must be in original state from at time of purchase; no modifications	No restrictions	No restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Writing or drawings of any kind are not allowed on either the backpack or binder (except a name label for appropriate identification purposes).</li> </ul>
Jewelry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limited to finger rings and one wristwatch only. Smart Watches must be in backpacks during school hours.</li> <li>• No bracelets unless they are Quail Lake issued.</li> <li>• No visible body piercings.</li> <li>• Earrings allowed only for female students and limited</li> </ul>			

	<p>to one stud earring per ear.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No dangling or hoop earrings.</li> <li>• Necklaces are to be tucked underneath polo shirt or spirit shirt.</li> </ul>			
Miscellaneous	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Athletic spirit wear may only be SUSD team apparel (may be from WAMS if student is playing for a WAMS team), and worn on game days during that sport's season only or spirit days.</li> <li>• Spirit shirts may be worn with jeans or uniform bottom on Fridays. Jeans with a polo shirt is not considered spirit wear for Friday.</li> <li>• Sanger High School sweatshirts and t-shirts may be worn on Fridays as part of spirit wear.</li> </ul> <p>If at anytime you are unsure about any part of the uniform policy or if an article of dress is acceptable, check with the office PRIOR to wearing the items to school.</p>
